*This general reference guide is intended to provide the latest COVID-19 guidance for COJUSD employees.*

| <b>Masks</b>                                  | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◦ Face Masks are not required</li> </ul>  |
| <b>COVID Vaccination Status</b>               | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◦ Vaccines are not required, strongly recommended</li> </ul>  |
| <b>COVID Exposures</b>                        | <p><b>Everyone, regardless of vaccination status. *Note: Persons infected within the prior 90 days do not need to be tested</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◦ Test within 3-5 days after last exposure.</li> <li>◦ Strongly encouraged to get vaccinated or boosted.</li> <li>◦ Per CDPH masking guidance, close contacts should wear a well-fitting mask around others for a total of 10 days, especially in indoor settings</li> <li>◦ If symptoms develop, test and stay home</li> </ul>   |
| <b>COVID Positive Cases/ Isolation Period</b> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◦ Stay home and isolate for at least 5 days</li> <li>◦ Isolation can end after day 5 (on day 6) <b>if</b> employees tests negative <b>and</b> no fever and symptoms have improved or are not present</li> <li>◦ If employee tests positive on day 5 or still has a fever, standard isolation period is 10 days</li> <li>◦ If an employee <u>chooses not to test</u> and their symptoms are not present or are resolving and have no fever, isolation ends <b>after day 10</b></li> <li>◦ Per CDPH masking guidance, infected persons should wear a well-fitting mask around others for a total of 10 days, especially in indoor settings</li> </ul> |
| <b>COVID Testing Schedule</b>                 | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◦ COJUSD offers COVID testing for employees and students at various school sites.
