



COJUSD Employee COVID Guidelines

This general reference guide is intended to provide the latest COVID-19 guidance for COJUSD employees.

Masks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Required indoors regardless of vaccination status ◦ Face shields <u>with a drape</u> (per CDPH Guidelines) requires social distancing (3 ft)
COVID Vaccination Status	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Vaccination is not required but strongly recommended, if not vaccinated must test weekly ◦ Employee vaccination status must be reported to Personnel
	You are UP-TO-DATE on your vaccination status if:
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Received a booster vaccine ◦ Recently vaccinated (received two doses of Pfizer/Moderna, one dose of J & J) and not yet eligible for booster dose ◦ Wait time for booster: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Pfizer vaccine was at least 5 months ago - Moderna vaccine was at least 6 months ago - J & J vaccine was at least 2 months ago
	You are NOT UP-TO-DATE on your vaccination status if:
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Have not received any COVID vaccines ◦ Have only received one dose of Pfizer/Moderna or it has not been 14 days since receiving last dose ◦ Received two doses of Pfizer/Moderna or one J & J dose and are eligible for booster ◦ Booster eligibility: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Pfizer vaccine was at least 5 months ago - Moderna vaccine was at least 6 months ago - J & J vaccine was at least 2 months ago
COVID Exposures/ Quarantine Period	Unvaccinated, Vaccinated and booster-eligible, but have NOT received booster dose
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Quarantine for 5 days after their last close contact with a <u>confirmed</u> positive case ◦ Quarantine can end after day 5 (on day 6) if employees tests negative and symptoms are not present including no fever ◦ If an employee <u>chooses not to test</u> and does not have symptoms, quarantine ends after day 10
	Boosted or Vaccinated and NOT booster-eligible
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ No quarantine required ◦ Recommended to test on day 5 ◦ Self-monitor for symptoms
COVID Positive Cases/ Isolation Period	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Isolate for at least 5 days ◦ Isolation can end after day 5 (on day 6) if employees tests negative and no fever and symptoms have improved or are not present ◦ If employee tests positive on day 5 or still has a fever, standard isolation period is 10 days ◦ If an employee <u>chooses not to test</u> and their symptoms are not present or are resolving and have no fever, isolation ends after day 10
