

Cutler-Orosi Joint Unified School District

Prohibited Activities

1. **Sedition.** Any use by any individual, society, group or organization for the commission of any act intended to further any program or movement whose purpose is the overthrow of the government of the United States or of the state by force, violence or other unlawful means. (Education code 38135)
2. **Incompatible Use.** Any use of school facilities or grounds which is inconsistent with school purposes or interferes with the regular conduct of school or school work.
3. **Games of Chance.** Games of chance, betting or any form of gambling and the conducting of raffles or lotteries are prohibited on District property.
4. **Conduct.** The use of profane language, quarreling or fighting is prohibited on District property.
5. **Weapons.** Firearms or other dangerous weapons are prohibited on school grounds as defined by law.
6. **Alcoholic beverages.** Alcoholic beverages may not be brought onto District grounds at any time. Any person under the influence of alcohol will be denied participation in any activity. Violation of these regulations is justification for immediate termination of the event, and denial of future use of school facilities.
7. **Tobacco-Free Policy.** Smoking and/or the use of tobacco products is prohibited on District property.
8. **Facility Alteration.** Permit holders are not authorized to alter any of the facilities in any manner or to erect, construct or bring onto District property any unauthorized vehicle, temporary building or structure. Users or attendees shall not adjust, tamper with or disable any utility system or panel including, but not limited to, electrical, heating, water, alarm and sprinkler systems.
9. **Decorations.** The use of scotch tape, thumbtacks, staples or nails on any wooden or painted surface is not permitted. Decorations must be removed at the end of the event. Decorations must be treated with flame retardant.
10. **Discrimination.** Users agree not to practice discrimination of any kind.
11. **Public Nuisance.** Any activity that constitutes a public nuisance, commission of a crime or any other act that is prohibited by law.

Other Rules and Regulations

1. **Gym Shoes.** Appropriate gym shoes are required for all activities on the uncovered floor of gymnasiums.
2. **Gymnasium Use.** No food or beverages may be served or consumed in the gymnasiums.
3. **Emergencies.** Facility Use Permits are canceled when a facility is closed due to an emergency.
4. **Cancellation.** Cancellation by applicants requires at least 24 hour prior notice. Otherwise, related actual costs shall be borne by the applicant.
5. **Permit Revocation.** Permits may be revoked whenever there has been a violation of the above regulations. The District reserves the right to refuse or revoke any authorization issued for the use of a school building or grounds and if rental fees have been paid, to refund such rental fees (pro-rated) less expenses incurred by the District in connection therewith.
6. **Fields/Rain.** Use of school playing fields is not permitted when it rains on the day of use, if the field is wet 48 hours preceding use or such activity will be harmful to the playing surface and when such conditions, in the District's opinion, may present a safety hazard to users.
7. **Field Lights.** If for any reason field lighting does not come on, the user must cancel the practice or event and report the problem to the District Office immediately the following day.
8. **Special set-ups.** Applicants are responsible for special set-up requirements and cleanup unless specifically requested in the application. Users are responsible for returning the facility to its original condition immediately following the event.
