THIS IS TO CERTIFY THAT THE UNDERSIGNED TEMPORARY COACH HAS MET THE REQUIREMENTS OF TITLE 5 CALIFORNIA CODE OF REGULATIONS 5593 AS FOLLOWS (CHECK APPROPRIATE BOXES):

(1) Must demonstrate knowledge of care and prevention of injuries and first aid through at least one of the following:

<input type="checkbox"/>	Completion of a college-level course in the care and prevention of injuries <u>and</u> possession of a valid CPR card; or
<input type="checkbox"/>	A valid sports injury certificate or first aid card, <u>and</u> a valid CPR card; or
<input type="checkbox"/>	A valid Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) I or II card; or
<input type="checkbox"/>	A valid trainer's certification issued by the National or California Athletic Trainers' Association; or
<input type="checkbox"/>	The person has had practical experience under the supervision of an athletic coach or trainer, or has assisted in team athletic training and conditioning, AND has BOTH valid CPR and first aid cards.

(2) Must demonstrate coaching theory and techniques in the sport or game being coached by at least one of the following:

<input type="checkbox"/>	Completion of a college course in the coaching theory or techniques; or
<input type="checkbox"/>	In-service programs arranged by a school district or a county office of education; or
<input type="checkbox"/>	Prior service as a student coach or assistant athletic coach in the sport or game being coached; or
<input type="checkbox"/>	Prior coaching in community youth athletic programs in the sport to be coached; or
<input type="checkbox"/>	Prior participation in organized competitive athletics at the high school level or above in the sport to be coached.

(3) Must demonstrate knowledge of the rules and regulations pertaining to the sport or game being coached, the league rules, and, at the high school level, regulations of the CIF.

(4) Must demonstrate knowledge of child or adolescent psychology as it relates to sports' participation by at least one of the following:

<input type="checkbox"/>	Completion of a college-level course in child psychology for elementary positions and adolescent or sports psychology for secondary positions; or
<input type="checkbox"/>	Completion of a seminar or workshop on human growth and development of youth; or
<input type="checkbox"/>	Prior active involvement with youth in a school or community sports program.

*Any of the above competencies (1) through (4) may be waived by the District Superintendent, provided the person is enrolled in a program leading to the acquisition of such competency. In such an instance, until the competencies are completed, the prospective coach must serve under the immediate supervision of a fully qualified temporary coach. IF ANY OF ABOVE COMPETENCIES IS BEING WAIVED, THE SIGNATURE OF THE SUPERINTENDENT IS REQUIRED.

<input type="checkbox"/>	High School Coaching Education Program approved by CIF and includes concussion training, has been completed by team and/or volunteer coach. (May not do a second season if not completed.) Validated completion in another district is acceptable.
<input type="checkbox"/>	The coach has been fingerprint cleared, passed TB clearance, and has no convictions of EC 44010, 44011, or 44424.
<input type="checkbox"/>	The coach has completed and approved training course on the nature and warning signs of sudden cardiac arrest. (yearly)

STANDARDS OF ETHICAL CONDUCT

The following standards of ethical conduct shall be required for all coaches:

- (1) Show respect for players, officials and other coaches.
- (2) Respect the integrity and judgment of game officials.
- (3) Establish and model fair play, sportsmanship, and proper conduct.
- (4) Establish player safety and welfare as the highest priority.
- (5) Provide proper supervision of students at all times.
- (6) Use discretion when providing constructive criticism and when reprimanding players.
- (7) Understand proper administrative chain of command and refer all requests or grievances through proper channels.
- (8) Maintain consistency in requiring all players to adhere to the established rules and standards of the game.
- (9) Properly instruct players in the safe use of equipment.
- (10) Avoid exerting undue influence on a pupil's decision to enroll in an athletic program at any public or private post-secondary educational institution.
- (11) Avoid exerting undue influence on students to take lighter academic course(s) in order to be eligible to participate in athletics.
- (12) Avoid suggesting, providing, or encouraging any athlete to use nonprescription drugs, anabolic steroids, or any substance to increase physical development or performance that is not approved by the United States Food and Drug Administration, Surgeon General of the United States, or American Medical Association.
- (13) Avoid recruitment of athletes from other schools.
- (14) Follow the rules of behavior and the procedures for crowd control as established by the local Board of Trustees and league in which the district participates.
